



Visitors

As an Ofsted registered childcare provider, we are very aware of our role in keeping your child/ren safe. Whilst children need to mix with other children and adults, it is our responsibility to ensure the suitability of those that they come into contact with during minded hours. We have therefore written the following policy regarding visitors in our settings during our minded hours.

- Any regular visitors to our settings will be asked to complete a CM2 form and will then undertake a DBS Check.
- We will not leave a minded child in a room alone with a visitor, unless we know they have been DBS cleared, for example another Ofsted Registered Childminder.
- We will not allow any visitors to take children to the toilet or change their nappies.
- We will request identification from all visitors not known to us and will refuse entry if we are unsure of them.
- We will endeavour, when possible, to arrange for any maintenance work to T&D properties to be carried out at weekends and during non-minding hours.
- We will maintain a visitor's book which is available for you to look at on request.
