



## **Emergency Evacuation**

In the unlikely event of an emergency evacuation when we have children in our care ie gas leak/fire/flood, we have a fire escape plan in place, and older children are all trained as we practice our fire drill regularly. Details of each fire drill is recorded within the fire drill section in our Risk Assessment folder.

If a smoke detector sounds, or a fire is detected, the priority is to evacuate the children from the building.

We have access to a telephone and a fire blanket that would only be used if a fire were preventing escape from the setting.

Fire Escape Plan:-

- Lead all children out of the house
- Assemble across the road at a safe distance and check that everyone is accounted for.
- Notify the fire brigade.
- Contact parents or their emergency contacts to arrange collection of the children
- Follow the instructions of the Emergency Services.
- Do not return to the building until the Emergency Services have declared it safe to do so.

We always carry our mobile phone which are charged. All contact numbers for each child is held on the phones (parent's contact numbers and emergency contacts).
